

X/4 C/S -- EAST GERMANY THINKS SOCIALISM STILL THREATENED IN CSSR
PRAGUE, AUGUST 29 (CMD) --- TWO ADN CORRESPONDENTS IN PRAGUE SAID

WEDNESDAY IN A REPORT THAT "COUNTER REVOLUTIONARY FORCES HAD, AS
COULD BE EXPECTED, BEGUN THE FIGHT AGAINST THE AGREEMENTS OF MOSCOW."

RALF BACHMANN AND WERNER HEYMANN WROTE THAT CZECHOSLOVAK "COUNTER-
REVOLUTION" WAS RESORTING "ABOVE ALL" TO THE "VARIOUS FREE RADIO
STATIONS."

THE ADN REPORT FOLLOWED BY ONLY A SHORT TIME ANOTHER STORY BY THE
AGENCY FROM PRAGUE, WHICH SAID THAT PRESIDENT LUDVIK SVOBODA, NATIONAL
ASSEMBLY CHAIRMAN JOSEF SMRKOVSKY, PREMIER OLDRICH CERNIK AND PARTY
LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK HAD "AGAIN" CALLED FOR "CALM AND PRUDENCE"
ON WEDNESDAY.

IN ITS REPORT ON COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY ACTIVITIES IN PRAGUE, ADN
SAID THAT "RIGHT-WING FORCES OF THE JOURNALISTS UNION HAD PRODUCED AN
ILLEGAL" NEWSPAPER, WHICH IS BEING DISTRIBUTED "IN VARIOUS PARTS OF
THE CITY."

ADN GOES ON TO ASSERT THAT THE TEXTS OF LEAFLETS AND OTHER PRODUCTS
OF "SECRET PRINTING SHOPS" DEMONSTRATE THAT "THE ENTIRE CAMPAIGN
AGAINST THE COMMUNIQUE (OF MOSCOW) IS BEING DIRECTED IN A COORDINATED
WAY."

THE ARGUMENTS IN THESE VARIOUS PUBLICATIONS, ADN SAYS, "ARE THE
SAME AS THOSE HEARD ON THE ILLEGAL RADIO STATIONS ON TUESDAY:
THE COMMUNIQUE IS TREASON -- NO CAPITULATION, AND COMMUNIQUE NO-
NEUTRALITY YES."

ADN ALSO SAID THAT EVEN PERSONALITIES "BEHIND WHOM COUNTER-
REVOLUTION HAD HIDDEN UNTIL NOW, LIKE PRESIDENT SVOBODA" ARE NOW BEING
SUBJECTED TO ATTACKS. THE NEWS AGENCY SAID THAT THE NAME OF SVOBODA HAD
BEEN CROSSED OFF WALL POSTERS. IT ALSO SAID THAT THE "INCITEMENT TO
MURDER" AGAINST CERTAIN POLITICAL FIGURES HAD - "IF POSSIBLE,
BECOME MORE HYSTERICAL".

IN CONCLUSION, THE NEWS AGENCY SAID THAT DESPITE THESE
MANIFESTATIONS OF COUNTER-REVOLUTION, THE MAJORITY OF PRAGUE RESIDENTS
APPEARED TO BE BREATHING MORE EASILY SINCE THE COMMUNIQUE.
