X/4 CURT - PRAGUE CONDITIONS DISCUSSED

MUNICH, AUGUST 29 (CMD)- THE CHAIRMEN OF TWO PRAGUE DISTRICTS, WEDNESDAY CALLED FOR A SPEEDY EVACUATION OF THE RIEGER PARK AND THE LETNA PLAIN AREAS OF PRAGUE BY OCCUPATION TROOPS.

THE CALLS WERE MADE DURING A MEETING OF PRAGUE MAYOR LUDVIK CERNY WITH CHAIRMEN OF ALL TEN PRAGUE DISTRICTS.

RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA WHICH REPORTED ABOUT THE MEETING, SAID THE CHAIRMEN DREW ATTENTION TO THE FACT THAT THERE WAS UNEXPLODED AMMUNITION IN SOME DISTRICTS OF THE CITY.

THEY APPEALED TO THE POPULATION NOT RPT NOT TO REMOVE MILITARY OBJECTS BY THEMSELVES, BUT RATHER TO TELL POLICE ABOUT IT.

EARLIER TONIGHT, THE RADIO CARRIED A REPORT ABOUT THE SITUATION IN SOME PRAGUE PLACES.

THE RADIO SAID THE BUILDING OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE IS EMPTY BUT FOR THE "POLITICAL SERVICE" AND AND POLICE WHO WER TOLD BY PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK NOT RPT NOT TO ALLOW ANYBODY TO ENTER.

THE REPORT SAID THAT TWO SOVIET ARMORED CARS WERE STANDING 50 METERS FROM THE BUILDING.

THE RADIO ALSO SAID THAT THE TRAVEL OFFICE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK YOUTH ORGANIZATION WAS WORKING NORMALLY, JUST AS DOES THE EDUCATION MINISTRY.

"THIS MEANS THAT CLASSES IN SCHOOLS OF THE FIRST AND SECOND CYCLE BEGIN ON SPETEMBER 2....," THE RADIO SAID.
