

MUNICH, AUGUST 29 (CMD)- RADIO WARSAW'S CORRESPONDENT IN PRAGUE, CZESLAW BERENDA, SAID WEDNESDAY NIGHT THAT "THE OFFICIAL COMMUNIQUE ON THE RESULTS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS AND ALSO RADIO SPEECHES BY PRESIDENT SVOBODA AND ALEXANDER DUBCEK WERE RECEIVED TUESDAY IN AN ATMOSPHERE OF SERIOUS TENSION AND HYSTERIA UNLEASHED BY UNDERGROUND RADIO STATIONS AND ILLEGAL PAPERS, POSTERS AND LEAFLETS."

HE SAID THAT THE MOST IMPORTANT POINTS IN THE SPEECHES BY DUBCEK AND SVOBODA WERE THE RESUMPTION OF NORMAL ACTIVITY OF CENTRAL STATE ORGANS, AND THE DECISIONS CONCERNING THE GRADUAL WITHDRAWAL OF THE WARSAW PACT ARMIES.

THE CORRESPONDENT SAID THAT DUBCEK'S DECISION TO TAKE OVER THE COMMAND OF THE PEOPLE'S MILITIA IS DRAWING LIVELY COMMENTS IN PRAGUE.

UNFORTUNATELY, SAID THE CORRESPONDENT, ONE COULD SEE A LOT OF EXAMPLES OF VISIBLE ACTIONS OF THOSE FORCES WHICH WOULD LIKE TO STRIKE THE WORD "SOCIALISM" FROM THE POLITICAL DICTIONARY OF THE COUNTRY.

"THESE FORCES ARE NOW CLEARLY AWARE THAT VICTORY IS NOT ON THEIR SIDE, AND THIS IS THE REASON FOR THEIR VIOLENT REACTION TO THE FACTUAL AND PRUDENT STAND OF PRESIDENT SVOBODA, WHO APPEALS FOR PRUDENCE, PEACE, CONFIDENCE AND ORDER IN THE WELL-UNDERSTOOD INTERESTS OF THE CZECH AND SLOVAK NATIONS."

BERENDA SAID THAT THE UNDERGROUND RADIO STATIONS CONTINUED TO MAINTAIN THE PSYCHOSIS OF UNCERTAINTY AND ANXIETY.

"WITH UNWILLINGNESS AND EVEN WITH HOSTILITY ONE COMMENTS HERE UPON THE JOINT DECISIONS WHICH WERE AGREED UPON DURING THE TALKS IN MOSCOW," SAID THE CORRESPONDENT.
