FREE CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION

VIENNA, AUG. 29 (RFE SPECIAL/KOSTRBA)--"FREE CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION - STUDIO MORAVSKA OSTRAVA" AGAIN OPENED OPERATION WEDNESDAY AT 1900 HRS WITH LOCAL AND FOREIGN NEWS, FOLLOWED BY A FILM REPORT FROM MORAVSKA OSTRAVA'S POST OFFICE, MAIN RAILWAY STATION AND AIR TERMINAL. WHILE LOCAL RAILWAY AND ROAD TRAFFIC IS SLOWLY RETURNING TO NORMAL, AIR TRAFFIC IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA REMAINS DISCONTINUED SINCE WEDNESDAY (AUG. 21).

THE MORAVSKA OSTRAVA BROADCAST CONTINUED DURING THE EVENING WITH READING FROM CZECH POET JAROSLAV SEIFERT'S WORKS, FOLLOWED BY THE CZECH FILM "JAN HUS".

AFTER A LATE NIGHT ROUND-UP OF NEWS MORAVSKA OSTRAVA SIGNED OFF AT 2320.

BRITISH LAWMAKERS DEMAND WITHDRAWAL

LONDON, AUG. 29 REUTER - NINETEEN MEMBERS OF BRITAIN'S RULING LABOUR PARTY WEDNESDAY NIGHT CABLED TO THE SOVIET NEWSPAPER PRAVDA A DEMAND FOR THE IMMEDIATE WITHDRAWAL OF SOVIET TROOPS FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

AMONG THOSE SIGNING THE LETTER WERE PROMINENT LEFTWING MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT MICHAEL FOOT AND IAN MUKARDO.

THE LETTER SAID: "WE HAVE ALWAYS AFFIRMED THE RIGHT OF EACH NATION TO DETERMINE ITS OWN POLITICAL SYSTEM WITHOUT INTERFERENCE FROM OTHER STATES".

ECUADOR SCORES SOVIET INTERVENTION

ECUADOR WEDNESDAY SENT A LETTER TO SECRETARY GENERAL U THANT PROTESTING THE SOVIET INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA. QUOTING FROM AN EARLIER STATEMENT BY THE FOREIGN MINISTER OF ECUADOR, CHARGE D'AFFAIRS HUGO JATIVA WROTE:

"ECUADOR, A STEADFAST DEFENDER OF THE PRINCIPLES OF NON-INTERVENTION, SELF-DETERMINATION AND THE PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES, BELIEVES THAT THERE CANNOT BE ANY ORDER OR LASTING PEACE BASED ON INJUSTICE AND VIOLENCE, AND IT CONDEMNS ALL FORMS OF IMPERIALISM AND AGGRESSION FROM ANY QUARTER WHATSOEVER.

"THE GOVERNMENT OF ECUADOR DECLARES THAT THE EVENTS WHICH HAVE TAKEN PLACE CONSTITUTE AN ACT OF AGGRESSION AGAINST A SOVEREIGN STATE AND ARE THEREFORE IN CONFLICT WITH THE PURPOSES AND PRINCIPLES STATED IN ARTICLE ONE AND TWO OF THE UNITED NATIONS CHARTER".

THE ECUADORIAN MISSION SAID THAT THE SENATE AND THE CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES OF ECUADOR ALSO APPROVED RESOLUTIONS CONDEMNING THE ARMED ACTION TAKEN AGAINST CZECHOSLOVAKIA.
