

X/4/9 CS - POLES TRYING TO ESTABLISH CONTACTS

MUNICH, AUGUST 29 (CMD) -- RADIO WARSAW SAID WEDNESDAY NIGHT THAT POLISH OCCUPATION TROOPS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WERE "PATIENTLY TRYING TO ESTABLISH CONTACTS" WITH THE LOCAL PEOPLE TO EXPLAIN THEY WERE THERE TO PROTECT THE SECURITY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE RADIO CORRESPONDENT, BOHDAN KOSTRZECKI, SAID THAT AFTER THE RADIO ADDRESSES DELIVERED BY CZECHOSLOVAK PRESIDENT LUDVEK SVOBODA AND PARTY LEADER ALEXANDER DUBCEK "THE ATMOSPHERE IN HRADEC KRALOVE (NORTH EAST BOHEMIA) AND IN OTHER PLACES IN THE VICINITY OF WHICH POLISH UNITS ARE STATIONED HAS VISIBLY RELAXED."

HE SAID THAT IN HRADEC KRALOVE THE LOCAL COMMITTEE OF NATIONAL FRONT ASKED THE POPULATION TO REMOVE "PROVOCATIVE AND SLANDERING SLOGANS" FROM SHOP WINDOWS.

THE CORRESPONDENT SAID THAT "COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY, ANTI-POLISH AND ANTI-SOVIET SLOGANS" ARE ALSO BEING REMOVED IN DVUR KRALOVE AND IN OTHER PLACE.

HOWEVER, SAID THE CORRESPONDENT, ANTI-SOCIALIST AND EXTRMIST GROUPS CONTINUE THEIR ACTIVITY, USING UNDERGROUND RADIO STATIONS AND PRESS FOR STIRRING UP PUBLIC OPINION, AND THE SPREADING OF CONFUSION AND PROVOCATION.

"ATTACKS AGAINST THE CONTENT AND THE SPIRIT OF THE MOSCOW TALKS ARE BEING BROADCAST BY THE RADIO, AS WELL AS APPEALS DIRECTED AT TORPEDOING THE RECOMMENDATIONS GIVEN IN RADIO SPEECHES BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS," HE SAID.

HE SAID THAT POLISH OFFICERS AND SOLDIERS TREATED THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA IWITH "GREAT SERIOUSNESS."

THAT THE POLISH TROOPS WERE PATIENTLY TRYING TO ESTABLISH CONTACTS WITH THE POPULATION EXPLAINING TO THE PEOPLE THE REASONS AND THE TASKS WHICH BROUGHT THEM HERE, NAMELY TO PROTECT THE SECURITY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AND THUS THAT OF THE WHOLE SOCIALIST COMMUNITY, HE SAID.
