

X/4 C/S - 2ND ADD HUSAK ELECTED (CN 73) XXX SECRETARIES

RADIO FREE DANUBE SAID THE CONGRESS WAS ATTENDED BY 607 DELEGATES OUT OF 638 ELECTED DELEGATES, WHICH MAKES 94.6 PERCENT OF DELEGATES WITH DECISIVE VOTE, IT SAID.

A DELEGATION OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY ATTENDED THE CONGRESS. THE RADIO SAID IT INCLUDED HUSAK, FRANTISEK BARBIREK, AND STEFAN SADOVSKY.

GUESTS OF HONOR WERE FRANTISEK VODSLON AND LIBUSE HRDINOVA.

THE CONGRESS DEALT WITH THE EXTRAORDINARILY COMPLEX INTERNAL-POLITICAL SITUATION CREATED BY THE ENTRY INTO CZECHOSLOVAKIA OF MILITARY UNITS OF FIVE WARSAW PACT MEMBER STATES, THE FINAL COMMUNIQUE OF THE CONGRESS SAID ACCORDING TO THE RADIO.

"THAT ABNORMAL AND GRAVE SITUATION CHARACTERIZED THE WHOLE DISCUSSION OF THE CONGRESS. AS A RESULT THE CONGRESS COULD NOT RPT NOT DISCUSS THE ORIGINALLY DETERMINED POINTS OF THE AGENDA....," THE COMMUNIQUE ADDED.

HUSAK REPORTED ON THE MOSCOW TALKS. THE COMMUNIQUE SAID, HE "POINTED OUT THE POSSIBLE WAY OUT OF THE CREATED ABNORMAL SITUATION. THE ONLY REASONABLE WAY OUT IS A POLITICAL SOLUTION OF THE SITUATION, KEEPING IN MIND THE HARD AND INEXORABLE REALITY OF THE PRESENCE OF TROOPS OF THE WARSAW PACT ON OUR SOIL. ANY OTHER ALTERNATIVE WOULD BRING FOR OUR PEOPLE UNIMAGINABLE SACRIFICES IN LIVES AND DISASTROUS ECONOMIC CONSEQUENCES."
