X/4 C/S - 4TH ADD HUSAK ELECTED (CN 75) XXX REPORTED

THE COMMUNIQUE ALSO SAID THAT AFTER THE END OF THE DISCUSSION THE SLOVAK CONGRESS ADOPTED "A RESOLUTION ON THE CURRENT POLITICAL SITUATION IN SLOVAKIA IN WHICH IT VOICED ITS FULL CONFIDENCE IN THE FIRST SECRETARY OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, ALEXANDER DUBCEK."

THE COMMUNIQUE THEN ADDED: "IN THE INTEREST OF A QUIET DEVELOPMENT OF OUR HOMELAND, IN THE INTEREST OF THE POSSIBILITY OF CONTINUING THE POST-JANUARY DEVELOPMENT IN OUR COUNTRY, AND IN THE INTEREST REALIZING THE ACTION PROGRAM OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, THE EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS SAW NO RPT NO OTHER POSSIBILITY BUT TO SUPPORT THE REALIZATION OF THE RESULTS OF THE MOSCOW TALKS."

THE COMMUNIQUE ALSO CALLED FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF POLITICAL CONDITIONS IN ORDER TO MAKE POSSIBLE THE FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF THE ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL SOCIAL LIFE.

"ONLY THAT ROAD WILL LEAD TO A RESTORATION OF ORDER, TO THE FURTHER DEEPENING OF THE DEMOCRATIZATION PROCESS, TO THE UNCONDITIONAL AND URGENT DEPARTURE OF THE TROOPS OF THE WARSAW PACT FROM THE TERRITORY OF OUR REPUBLIC, AND THUS TO THE RESTORATION AND FURTHER STRENGTHENING OF OUR NATIONAL AND STATE SOVEREIGNTY," THE COMMUNIQUE SAID.

THE COMMUNIQUE ALSO SUPPORTED A FEDERAL SET-UP OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.
