X/4 C/S - 5TH ADD HUSAK ELECTED (CN 79) XXX CZECHOSLOVAKIA

THE COMMUNIQUE SAID 41 DELEGATES SPOKE TO THE CONGRESS. TWO SPEAKERS INFORMED THE CONGRESS ABOUT LAST WEEKS EXTRAORDINARY CONGRESS OF THE CZECHSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, AND ABOUT CONSULTATIONS OF SOME MEMBERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE ON AUGUST 26 IN PRAGUE .

THE EXTRAORDINARY SLOVAK CONGRESS HAS RECEIVED NUMEROUS MESSAGES OF "UNSWERVING SUPPORT" TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, ITS LEADING FUNCTIONARIES, AND THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT, THE COMMUNIQUE SAID.

THE CONGRESS ELECTED -- IN ADDITION TO 107 MEMBERS OF THE SLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE -- ALSO 24 ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE, AS WELL AS 28 MEMBERS OF THE CONGROL AND AUDIT COMMISSION OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY.

"IN CONCLUSION THE CONGRESS ADOPTED A LETTER TO THE FIRST SECRETARY OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE CZECHSOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY, ALEXANDER DUBCEK. THE LETTE EXPRESSES LOYALTY, ATTACHMENT, AND FULL SUPPORT OF SLOVAK COMMUNISTS TO DUBCEK," THE COMMUNIQUE SAID.
