C/S - COUNTER-REVOLUTION STILL ACTIVE, SAYS EAST BERLIN

BERLIN, AUG 29 (UPI) - NEUES DEUTSCHLAND, OFFICIAL EAST GERMAN COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER, TODAY SAID COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY ELEMENTS STILL ARE ACTIVE IN PRAGUE AND ARE PLOTTING TO UNDERMINE THE AGREEMENT REACHED BY CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS IN MOSCOW.

THE NEWSPAPER IN A STORY HEADLINED "THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION ORGANIZES ATTACK ON (MOSCOW) COMMUNIQUE" REPORTED THAT "COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY ELEMENTS ARE USING ANY MEANS TO AGITATE THE PEOPLE AND STIR UP NATIONALISTIC FEELINGS.

"ROGROM SLOGANS AND CALLS FOR LYNCH JUSTICE AGAINST DECENT COMMUNISTS STILL ARE PART OF THE DAILY LIFE OF PRAGUE.

"THE ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES HAVE GONE OVER TO ATTACK AGAINST THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS."

IT SAID THERE WERE SIGNS THAT "PROGRESSIVE FORCES" WERE BEGINNING TO RAISE THEIR HEADS "BUT AT THE SAME TIME COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY ELEMENTS ARE INCREASING THEIR ACTIVITY."

"ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES ARE ATTEMPTING WITH ALL MEANS TO DISCREDIT THE MOSCOW RESULTS IN THE EYES OF THE WORKING CLASS AND STIR UP NATIONALIST FEELING," IT SAID.
