

X/4 C/S - YUGOSLAV WEEKLY SAYS POLICY OF VIOLENCE FAILED

BELGRADE, AUG 29 (CMD) - THE YUGOSLAV COMMUNIST PARTY WEEKLY, KOMUNIST, SAID TODAY CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAD SHOWN THAT "AN ATTEMPT AT IMPOSING SOMEBODY ELSE'S WILL ON AN INDEPENDENT SOCIALIST STATE BY DIRECT VIOLENCE, HAD SUFFERED HEAVY FAILURE IDEOLOGICALLY AND POLITICALLY."

THE STATEMENT WAS CONTAINED IN AN EDITORIAL ASSESSING THE CZECHOSLOVAK SITUATION. HERE IS TANJUG'S REPORT ON THE KOMUNIST ARTICLE:

KOMUNIST, ORGAN OF THE LEAGUE OF COMMUNISTS OF YUGOSLAVIA, WRITES EDITORIALY TODAY THAT THE AGREEMENT IN MOSCOW SEEMS TO HAVE CREATED AT LEAST THE MOST ELEMENTARY CONDITIONS FOR AN ATTEMPT TO ENSURE A NORMALIZATION OF INTERNAL LIFE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA. THE CLIMAXES OF UNCERTAINTY AND AGGRAVATION OF THE CRISIS IN WHICH CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAS FOUND HERSELF OWING TO THE DEVELOPMENTS ON HER SOIL ... HAVE NOW BEEN PROBABLY OVERCOME, THE WEEKLY POINTS OUT.

OTHERWISE, KOMUNIST DRAWS TWO CONCLUSIONS FROM THE WHOLE SITUATION ABOUT CZECHOSLOVAKIA:

FIRST, IT IS CLEAR TO THE YUGOSLAV PUBLIC THAT AN ATTEMPT AT IMPOSING SOMEBODY ELSE'S WILL ON AN INDEPENDENT SOCIALIST STATE BY DIRECT VIOLENCE, HAS SUFFERED HEAVY FAILURE IDEOLOGICALLY AND POLITICALLY, AND

SECONDLY, BY THEIR UNITED, DIGNIFIED AND FIRM RESISTANCE, THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNISTS HAVE PROVED THEIR STRENGTH, MATURITY AND GENUINE ADHERENCE TO THE IDEALS OF SOCIALISM, AND ONE SHOULD NOT DOUBT THAT THEY WILL SUCCEED IN FIGHTING OUT THEIR COUNTRY'S RIGHT TO ITS OWN, AUTONOMOUS WAY TO SOCIALISM.

THE YUGOSLAV COMMUNISTS AND PEOPLE WILL GIVE THEM UTMOST SUPPORT IN THESE EFFORTS, KOMUNIST POINTS OUT. (TANJUG, AUG 29)
