X/13 CS -- NO CHANGE AT WEST GERMAN BORDER

MUNICH, AUG 29 (GND/MACDONALD) -- THERE WAS NO RPT NO CHANGE IN THE SITUATION TODAY AT THE BORDER CROSSING-POINTS BETWEEN WEST GERMANY AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA, THE BAVARIAN INTERIOR MINISTRY SAID.

AS YESTERDAY, SOVIET OFFICERS ARE STATIONED AT THE WAIDHAUS AND SCHIRNDING CONTROL POSTS BUT THE TRAVELERS ARE BEING CHECKED BY CZECHOSLOVAK OFFICIALS.

AT WAIDHAUS ONLY CZECHOSLOVAKS ARE BEING PERMITTED TO ENTER CZECHOSLOVAKS AND ONLY FOREIGNERS ALLOWED TO LEAVE IT. CZECHOSLOVAK CITIZENS WITH VALID PASSPORTS, HOWEVER, ARE STILL COMING OUT AT SCHIRNDING AND FURTH-IM-WALD.

AT THESE TWO BORDER POSTS, TOO, WESTERN BUSINESSMEN, PATIENTS SCHEDULED TO TAKE CURES AT CZECHOSLOVAK SPAS AND GERMANS WITH RELATIVES IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA ARE BEING ALLOWED TO ENTER.

AT NONE OF THE THREE CROSSING-POINTS ARE WESTERN TOURISTS OR JOURNALISTS BEING PERMITTED TO ENTER CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE CZECHOSLOVAK FLAGS AT THE CONTROL POSTS STILL FLY AT HALF-STAFF.
