X/4 C/S -- VLTAVA: TROOPS PULLOUT NOT PINNED TO RESTORATION OF CALM

MUNICH, AUG 29 (CMD) - RADIO VLTAVA, THE SOVIET-SUPPORTED CZECHOSLOVAK STATION, SAID TODAY THAT RESTORATION OF PUBLIC ORDER WAS NOT RPT NOT THE SOLE BASIS FOR SETTING THE TIMETABLE FOR THE DEPARTURE OF FOREIGN TROOPS FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

APPEALS FOR THE RE-INTRODUCTION OF CALM AND ORDER ONLY TO SPEED UP TROOP DEPARTURES "BENEFIT NO RPT NO ONE," THE RADIO SAID.

THE RADIO ADDED:

"IN HARMONY WITH THE AGREEMENTS CONTAINED IN THE (MOSCOW) COMMUNIQUE THE DEPARTURE OF THE TROOPS FROM CZECHOSLOVAKIA WILL DEPEND ON HOW THE SITUATION IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC IS BEING NORMALIZED.

"CERTAINLY IT WOULD BE A MISTAKE TO MIX UP THE CAUSE AND THE EFFECT. THE TROOPS CAME TO THE COUNTRY BECAUSE THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION WAS CREATING AN ABNORMAL SITUATION.

"LET US SAY IT OPENLY: PRIMARILY IT DOES NOT RPT NOT CONCERN THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY POSTERS AND SCRAWLS WHICH ARE BEING REMOVED FROM THE STREETS, BUT RATHER THE POLITICAL PROBLEMS WHICH ARE CONNECTED WITH THE STABILIZATION OF THE SOCIALIST STATE POWER IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC.

"IMPORTANT IS WHAT PRESIDENT SVOBODA SAID IN HIS SPEECH YESTERDAY: THE PLACE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC CAN NOT RPT NOT BE ANYWHERE ELSE, BUT IN THE COMMUNITY OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES," RADIO VLTAVA SAID.
