

OCCUPATION CONCERT A FLOP

MUNICH, AUG 29 (CMD)-- RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA SAID TODAY A CONCERT ORGANIZED BY "FOREIGN TROOPS FOR PRAGUE CITIZENS" DREW ONLY 30 CZECHOSLOVAKS AND EIGHT SOVIET PHOTOGRAPHERS LAST NIGHT.

"GREAT PREPARATIONS WERE MADE FOR THE CONCERT," THE RADIO SAID, "AND WHERE THE STAGE WAS CONSTRUCTED THE ORGANIZERS DESTROYED THE LAWN, WHICH HAD BEEN CULTIVATED WITH GREAT CARE."

THE CONCERT WAS HELD IN THE RIEGER GARDENS, THE RADIO SAID. HALF OF THE 30 CZECHOSLOVAKS PRESENT WERE CHILDREN, THE REPORT SAID. (RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN CZECH, 0900)

RADIO POINTS OUT SOVIET CHANGE ON DUBCEK.

MUNICH, AUG 29 (CMD)-- RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN A GERMAN-LANGUAGE BROADCAST TODAY, SAID THAT THE SOVIET PARTY ORGAN PRAVDA HAS AGAIN DESCRIBED ALEXANDER DUBCEK AS CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY LEADER.

"ONLY SIX DAYS AGO," THE REPORT SAID, "HE WAS DESCRIBED IN THE SAME PAPER AS THE LEADER OF THE MINORITY IN THE PRESIDIUM OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE."

"THIS IS A CIRCUMSTANCE TO WHICH FOREIGN CORRESPONDENTS IN MOSCOW ATTACH SPECIAL WEIGHT," THE GERMAN-LANGUAGE BROADCAST SAID. (RADIO CZECHOSLOVAKIA IN GERMAN, 1000)

TWO ITALIAN UNIONS CEASE WORK FOR CS

ROME, AUG. 29--(RFE SPECIAL TEMPEST)--- THOUSANDS OF ITALIAN WORKERS WILL STOP WORK TOMORROW MORNING FOR FIVE MINUTES TO PROTEST THE ARMED INTERVENTION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND TO EXPRESS SOLIDARITY WITH CZECHOSLOVAK WORKERS.

TWO MAJOR ITALIAN UNIONS ANNOUNCED THE WORK STOPPAGE IN REPLY TO REQUESTS OF A "GREAT NUMBER" OF WORKERS, ACCORDING TO A UNION COMMUNIQUE.

THE UNIONS -- THE SOCIALIST ITALIAN WORKERS UNION (UIL) AND THE CHRISTIAN DEMOCRAT ITALIAN CONFEDERATION OF WORKERS UNIONS (CISL)---SAID THE STOPPAGE WOULD TAKE PLACE AT 900 HOURS (MT).

THE COMMUNIST-DOMINATED ITALIAN GENERAL CONFEDERATION OF WORKERS (CGIL) IS NOT RPT NOT TAKING PART IN THE DEMONSTRATION, THOUGH IT PROTESTS STRONGLY AGAINST SOVIET INTERVENTION IN A COMMUNIQUE ISSUED IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE INVASION.
