

X-13/CS ---- FRENCH CP HOPES MOSCOW ACCORDS BE IMPLEMENTED

PARIS AUG. 29 (RFE SPECIAL/OVADIA) --- THE EDITOR-IN-CHIEF OF THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY DAILY L'HUMANITE, CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBER RENE ANDRIEU, SAID THURSDAY THAT, "IN THE INTEREST OF SOCIALISM", IT WAS TO BE HOPED THAT THE MOSCOW ACCORDS ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA WILL BE IMPLEMENTED.

THE ACCORDS, SAID ANDRIEU IN A SHORT COMMENT PUBLISHED THIS MORNING ON L'HUMANITES FRONT PAGE UNDER THE TITLE "IN THE INTEREST OF SOCIALISM", HAD "DE-DRAMATIZED" A SITUATION WHICH "AT ANY MOMENT COULD HAVE LED TO THE WORST".

THEREFORE, ANDRIEU RECALLED, THE POLITBURO OF THE FRENCH COMMUNIST PARTY HAD "NOTED AS A POSITIVE FACT THAT AN ACCORD HAD BEEN REACHED".

"WE NOW FIRMLY HOPE", ANDRIEU SAID, "THAT THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ACCORD BETWEEN THE SOVIET AND CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS WILL OPEN THE ROAD FOR THE INDISPENSABLE POLITICAL SOLUTION, IN THE INTEREST OF THE PEOPLES OF THE USSR AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA, IN THE INTEREST OF SOCIALISM".

A FEW DAYS AGO, ANDRIEU HAD CALLED THE MILITARY INTERVENTION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA "A TRAGIC ERROR".
