

X/13 EURO - 1ST ADD - HARD-LINERS PROTEST (CN 145) XXX RUPTURE?

"DISAGREEMENT MUST BE SETTLED THROUGH DISCUSSION. PATERNALISTIC AND SECTARIAN POSITIONS (BUT ALSO ~~FORMIT~~) WERE CERTAINLY TO BE FOUND IN NOVOTNY. BUT, HOWEVER, MANY OF THE VERY SERIOUS CHARGES RAISED AGAINST THEM ~~UTTERLY~~ ARE ABSURD."

SENATOR GIULIANO PAJETTA ENDORSED LONGO'S SPEECH, CONFIRMING THAT THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT WAS ONLY A COMPROMISE AND REITERATING HIS CONFIDENCE IN THE SOVIET UNION.

"THE JUDGEMENT ON THE AGREEMENT REACHED IN MOSCOW BETWEEN THE SOVIET AND CZECHOSLOVAK PARTIES WHICH CAN NOT RPT NOT BUT BE DEFINED AS A COMPROMISE IS COMPLEX AND DIFFICULT IN CONSIDERATION OF THE WAY IN WHICH IT WAS REACHED: UNDER CONDITIONS WHICH COULD NOT RPT NOT BE HELD THOSE OF EQUALITY..."

IN OUR POSITION OF CRITICISM OVER THE GRAVE ERRORS OF THE SOVIET PARTY, WE EXPRESS OUR DEEP FAITH IN THE SOVIET UNION AND IN SOCIALISM, IN THE CERTAINTY THAT ERRORS CAN BE CORRECTED.

"IN THE NAME OF INTERNATIONALISM RESPONSIBILITIES AND ERRORS WHICH, ABOVE ALL HARM THE SOVIET UNION ITSELF AND ITS IDEALS OF LIBERTY AND SOCIALISM, MUST NOT RPT NOT BE CONCEALED."

POLITBUREAU MEMBERS GIORGIO AMENDOAL AND GIANCARLO PAJETTA BOTH SPOKE LENGTHILY YESTERDAY AND ENDORSED LONGO'S DECLARATION OF PCI POLICY.

THE JOINT SESSION OF THE COMMITTEE AND COMMISSION RESUMED DISCUSSION AT 0730 HOURS (MT) THIS MORNING. LONGO IS EXPECTED TO SPEAK AGAIN TODAY TO WIND UP THE DEBATE.
