TOURIST CONGRESS CANCELLED

MADRID, AUG 29 (UPI)--THE 19TH INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF SCIENTIFIC EXPERTS OF TOURISM, SCHEDULED TO BE HELD IN BULGARIA NEXT MONTH, HAS BEEN CALLED OFF BECAUSE OF THE EAST EUROPEAN SITUATION, THE CONGRESS PRESIDENT ANNOUNCED HERE TODAY.

THE PRESIDENT, JORGE VILA FREADERA OF SPAIN, SAID THE CONGRESS WAS SCHEDULED TO BE HELD IN VARNA, BULGARIA, ON SEPT. 1.

VILA FRADERA SAID THIS IS THE FIRST TIME IN 19 YEARS THAT THE CONGRESS HAD BEEN SUSPENDED "AND IT IS DUE TO THE SAD CIRCUMSTANCES TOTALLY OPPOSED TO THE SPIRIT OF THE INTERNATIONAL TOURISM."

YUGOSLAV YOUTHS URGED DRIVE ON AGGRESSION

BELGRADE, AUG. 29, REUTER - THE YUGOSLAV FEDERATION OF YOUTH TODAY SENT A LETTER TO WORLD YOUTH ORGANISATIONS CALLING FOR JOINT ACTION TO PREVENT AGGRESSION AND TO REHABILITATE SOCIALISM, TANJUG NEWS AGENCY REPORTED.

THE LETTER DEPLORED THAT THE INTERNATIONAL YOUTH MOVEMENT HAD OFTEN BEEN A POLITICAL INSTRUMENT OF THE BIG POWERS, AND THAT IT HAD NOT SUCCEEDED IN SECURING THE INFLUENCE OF THE YOUNGER PROGRESSIVE GENERATION ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS.
