

FURTHER "EVIDENCE" OF THE "FEAR WHICH THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES HAVE OF THE TRUTH" WAS SEEN BY NEUES DEUTSCHLAND IN THE FACT THAT "REACTIONARY FORCES SMEARED INCITING SLOGANS ACROSS THE TITLE OF OUR NEWSPAPER (DISPLAYED) AT OUR HOUSE IN PRAGUE."

THE PAPER ALSO SAID THAT THE HOTEL ALCRON IN PRAGUE, WHERE PRIMARILY WEST GERMAN AND OTHER FOREIGN JOURNALISTS WERE GATHERING, "IS ENTERED IN REGULAR INTERVALS BY WELL-DRESSED GIRLS, WHOSE LOOKS DON'T IMMEDIATELY BETRAY THEIR TRADE, AS TALEBEARERS OF INCITING REPORTS."

SIMILARLY, THE SEMI-OFFICIAL COMMUNIST (EAST) BERLINER ZEITUNG REPORTED FROM THE CZECHOSLOVAK CAPITAL THAT "NOISY GROUPS" WERE BEING CALLED TOGETHER AT VARIOUS POINTS OF THE CITY "IN ORDER TO STAGE 'PROTEST RALLIES'." THEY WERE ALWAYS COMPOSED OF THE SAME PEOPLE, BERLINER ZEITUNG MAINTAINED, "LIKE ON WEDNESDAY MORNING IN FRONT OF THE PRESENT SEAT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ON GORKI SQUARE WHERE IT WAS ATTEMPTED TO CALUMNIATE THE RESULT OF THE MOSCOW CONSULTATIONS AS 'TRAGIC' AND 'DEGRADING'."

(WHILE IT WAS NOT RPT NOT CLEAR FROM THE REPORT WHETHER THIS "ATTEMPT" REFERRED TO THE PROTEST RALLY OR TO THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY ITSELF, BERLINER ZEITUNG AS WELL AS THE OTHER MAJOR EAST GERMAN NEWSPAPERS FAILED TO MAKE ANY DIRECT MENTION OF THE RESOLUTION IN WHICH THE PARLIAMENT CONDEMNED THE OCCUPATION AND MADE VARIOUS DEMANDS INCLUDING THE RELEASE OF ALL CZECHOSLOVAKS ARRESTED AFTER AUG. 21.)

LIKE THE OTHER DAILIES BERLINER ZEITUNG CLAIMED THAT AGITATION KEPT INTENSIFYING EVEN AGAINST THOSE LEADERS "BEHIND WHOM THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES TRIED TO HIDE SO FAR." THUS "COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY ELEMENTS ON THEIR WAY TO THE PARLIAMENT BUILDING RIPPED DOWN PICTURES OF PRESIDENT SVOBODA AND ALEXANDER DUBCEK AND TREMPLED THEM UNDERFOOT," BERLINER ZEITUNG REPORTED. IT ALSO REGISTERED THAT DURING DEMONSTRATIONS IN PRAGUE YESTERDAY DEMANDS FOR THE OUSTING OF "THE FIRST SECRETARY OF THE KPC CENTRAL COMMITTEE, ALEXANDER DUBCEK, WERE RAISED."

AT THE SAME TIME, THE REPORT SAID, THE "INCITEMENT TO MURDER ('MORDHETZE') AGAINST "A NUMBER OF OTHER (LEADING CZECHOSLOVAK) PERSONALITIES HAS BECOME STILL MORE HYSTERICAL THAN BEFORE." BEHIND THEIR NAMES, WRITTEN ON THE WALLS OF BUILDINGS, "GALLOWS WITH OPEN NOOSES ARE BEING SMEARED, OR THE INSCRIPTIONS SAY: 'BILAK, KOLDER, INDRA, LENART -- YOU WILL ALL MEET AT THE GALLOWS'."

THE EAST GERMAN NEWSPAPERS SAID THAT IN THEIR ACTIVITIES AGAINST THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS THE "COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARIES" WERE PRIMARILY EMPLOYING "THE 'FREE RADIO STATIONS'."
