X/4 C/S - NO RPT NO LONGER CURFEW, RADIO SAYS

MUNICH, AUGUST 29 - (CMD)- RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA
SAID TONIGHT THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT HAD BEEN TOLD
BY REPRESENTATIVES OF OCCUPATION TROOPS THAT THERE NO LONGER EXISTS
ANY CURFEW IN CENTRAL BOHEMIA AND IN PRAGUE.

THE GOVERNMENT ALSO TOLD CZECHOSLOVAKS WHO ARE STILL ABROAD
THAT CONDITIONS AT THE BORDERS WILL ENABLE THEM
TO RETURN HOME.

THE BROADCAST SAID (TEXT):

"THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CSSR HAS BEEN
ASSURED BY REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ALLIED ARMIES OF THE WARSAW
TREATY THAT NO RPT NO TIME LIMIT FOR THE
CITIZENS' LEAVING THEIR HOMES OR ARRIVING IN THEM
IS SET IN THE CENTRAL BOHEMIAN REGION AND IN THE CAPITAL
OF PRAGUE.

"THUS CITIZEN MAY LEAVE THEIR HOMES AND ARRIVE AT HOME
AT ANY HOUR.

"THIS WILL ENABLE AN ORDERLY GOING TO THE (PLACE
OF) EMPLOYMENT AND FROM EXMPLOYMENT, PARTICULARLY DURING
AFTERNOON AND NIGHT SHIFTS."
