

X/4 C/S - BUDAPEST: C/S MUST ACCOMPLISH MOSCOW OBLIGATIONS

MUNICH, AUGUST 29 - (CMD)- RADIO BUDAPEST SAID TONIGHT THE LEADERSHIP OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY AS WELL AS THE PARTY MUST FULFILL OBLIGATIONS ORIGINATING FROM THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT.

THE RADIO QUOTED THE HUNGARIAN NEWS AGENCY, MTI'S PRAGUE CORRESPONDENT GYOERGY HALASI ASS SAYING THAT "CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY AND GOVERNMENT BODIES ARE TAKING FURTHER MEASURES TO SETTLE THE SITUATION."

"THE CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LEADERSHIP AND GOVERNMENT FACE DIFFICULT TASKS BECAUSE THEY HAVE NOT RPT NOT ONLY TO NORMALIZE THE SHATTERED SITUATION AND LIVING CONDITIONS DUE TO THE ACTIVITY OF ANTI-SOCIALIST FORCES, BUT ALSO TO FULFILL THOSE OBLIGATIONS WHICH ORIGINATE FROM THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT," HALASI SAID.

HE SAID THAT "THIS IS NOT RPT NOT AN EASY TASK IN A COUNTRY IN WHICH PUBLIC OPINION HAS BEEN INFORMED IN THE LAST SIX MONTHS ONE - IDEDEDLY, ONLY FROM THE VIEWPOINT OF FORCES WHICH JEOPARDIZED THE POSITIONS OF SOCIALISM IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY THEIR ACTIVITY AND THIS FINALLY RESULTED IN THE PRESENT SITUATION."

HALASI SAID THAT NUMEROUS "FORCES ARE APPEARING IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA ONLY THREE DAYS AFTER THE MOSCOW TALKS INCITING AGAINST THE (MOSCOW) AGREEMENT AND TAKING A STAND FOR THE DECISIONS OF THE 14TH CONGRESS WHICH WAS SUMMONED IN AN ANTI-DEMOCRATIC AND ILLEGAL WAY."
