(CMD)- RADION ON THE DANUBE TONIGHT CARRIED AN APPEAL OF THE COUNCIL OF THE NATIONAL COMMITTEE OF BRATISLAVA WHICH SAID IT FULLY SUPPORTED THE TASKS SET BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY AND THE GOVERNMENT.

THE COMMITTEE SAID IT DEEMED NECESSARY -- THROUGH DISCIPLINE TO AVOID A SITUATION WHICH WOULD CAUSE A PROLONGATION OF THE STAY OF FOREIGN TROOPS IN THE CSSR;

--TO REMOVE ALL INSCRIPTIONS AND SLOGANS INSULTING THE FEELINGS OF OTHER NATIONS AND THEIR LEADERS;

-- NOT RPT NOT TO WRITE SUCH SLOGANS ANY MORE; AND

-- AVOID CROWDING IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PLACES.

THE COUNCIL NOTED THAT A VIOLATION OF THESE DIRECTIVES WOULD BE A VIOLATION "OF OUR OWN ORDERS."
