X/4 CS - NEW SLOVAK PRESIDUM SEES SITUATION AS CLAMER

MUNICH, AUG 29 (CMD)- THE NEWLY ELECTED PRESIDUM OF THE SLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE HAS SAID THE ATMOSPHERE IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA WAS CALMER, ACCORDING TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO STATION DUNAJ.
