

X/4 CURT - (R)- RUMANIAN SECURITY WORKERS ENDORSE STATE POLICIES

MUNICH, AUG 29 (CMD)- THE PRESIDENT OF RUMANIA'S STATE SECURITY COUNCIL, ION STANESCU, SAID TODAY RUMANIAN SECURITY WORKERS FULLY ENDORSE THEIR COUNTRY'S FOREIGN POLICY, ACCORDING TO RADIO BUCHAREST.

THE STATION SAID THAT MR. STANESCU MADE THIS REMARK WHILE ADDRESSING A MEETING TODAY IN BUCHAREST MARKING THE 20TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FOUNDING OF RUMANIA'S SECURITY ORGANS.

THE MEETING WAS ATTENDED BY RUMANIAN PARTY LEADER NICOLAE CEAUSESCU, PREMIER GHEORGHE MAURER, PARTY AND SECURITY OFFICIALS, AND WORKERS, ACCORDING TO RADIO BUCHAREST.

AT THE MEETING, THE STATION SAID, MR. CEAUSESCU PRESENTED HONORARY AWARDS TO SECURITY CADRES.

RADIO BUCHAREST SAID THE SECURITY ORGANS WERE "AN INSTRUMENT OF THE WORKING PEOPLE, OF THE PARTY AND STATE IN DEFENSE OF THE REVOLUTIONARY CONQUESTS OF THE PEOPLE, OF ITS PEACEFUL AND CREATIVE WORK SERVING SOCIALIST CONSTRUCTION."

ACCORDING TO THE STATION, MR. STANESCU'S SPEECH CONCERNED "THE GREAT IDEOLOGICAL AND ORGANIZATIONAL ACTIVITY OF THE PARTY IN THE MOBILIZATION OF THE PEOPLE IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW SOCIETY."

THE STATION QUOTED STANESCU AS SAYING: "UNDER THE PARTY'S LEADERSHIP AND WITH THE SUPPORT OF THE MASSES THE SECURITY DEVELOPED A FRUITFUL ACTIVITY AND CONTRIBUTED TO THE VICTORY AGAINST THE FORCES OF REACTION (AND) TO THE ASSURANCE OF PEACEFUL SOCIALIST CONSTRUCTION OF THE RUMANIAN PEOPLE."
