

X/4 C/S - BUDAPEST: NATION TRUSTS C/S LEADERS

MUNICH, AUGUST 29 (CMD)- RADIO BUDAPEST IN A BROADCAST FOR HUNGARIANS ABROAD SAID TONIGHT THAT THE AIMS OF CZECHOSLOVAK LEADERS COULD BE MADE EASIER BY THE TRUST OF THE NATION AND THE UNITY OF THE MASSES.

THE RADIO'S POLITICAL CORRESPONDENT, MAGDA HALASZ, SAID: "CZECHOSLOVAKIA IS STILL IN A COMPLICATED AND DIFFICULT POSITION."

SHE SAID "THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT ESTABLISHED THE BASIS FOR A POLITICAL SETTLEMENT, BUT THE AGREEMENT SHOULD BE ACCOMPLISHED IN PERSISTENT AND DIFFICULT POLITICAL STRUGGLES AND NOBODY CAN DELUDE HIMSELF THAT THIS STRUGGLE WILL BE EASY."

"THE AIMS OF CONSOLIDATING AND ACCOMPLISHING THE MOSCOW AGREEMENTS OF THE LEADING CZECHOSLOVAK POLITICIANS... COULD BE MADE EASIER BY THE TRUST OF THE NATION AND THE UNITY IN WHICH THE MASSES ARE GAHTERING BEHIND THEM (C/S LEADERS)", HALASZ SAID, AND ADDED:

"(THESE AIMS) COULD BE MADE MORE DIFFICULT BY THE FACT THAT UNDER THIS UNITY THERE ARE ALSO HIDING THE ENEMIES OF SOCIALISM WITH WHOM ONE CANNOT GO TOGETHER AS HAS BEEN PROVEN BY DEVELOPMENTS."

HALASZ SAID THAT "MANY DECLARATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE THESE DAYS EXPRESSING CONFIDENCE TOWARD PARTY AND GOVERNMENT BUT THESE DECLARATIONS ARE HIDING VERY DIFFERENT CONTENTS". (RADIO BUDAPEST FOR HUNGARIANS ABROAD, M, AUGUST 29, 1968, 2000 HRS).
