X/4 CS - MINISTERS WANT TO RETURN TO CSSR

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD)- RADIO PRAGUE TONIGHT QUOTED WESTERN REPORTS THAT CZECHOSLOVAK DEPUTY PREMIER OTA SIK AND FOUR CZECHOSLOVAK MINISTERS NOW OUTSIDE THE COUNTRY WANT TO RETURN HOME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

THE RADIO SAID LAST NIGHT (FULL TEXT):

"ACCORDING TO A REPORT OF THE AFP NEWS AGENCY, DEPUTY PREMIER OTA SIK AND THE MINISTERS TROKAN, VLASAK AND GASPARIK TODAY LEFT BELGRADE FOR VIENNA.

"FOREIGN AFFAIRS MINISTER DR. JIRI HAJEK LEFT BY PLANE FOR VIENNA.—

"ACCORDING TO AN ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY, ALL WANT TO RETURN TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE." (END TEXT)
