AUSTRIANS DENY INVOLVEMENT IN "GREEN BERETS" TO C/S  
VIENNA, AUG 30 (RFE SPECIAL/KOCH)--THE AUSTRIAN AMBASSADOR IN MOSCOW  
WAS INSTRUCTED TO LODGE A SHARP PROTEST WITH THE SOVIET FOREIGN  
MINISTRY AGAINST CLAIMS BY A SOVIET LITERARY PUBLICATION THAT AUSTRIA  
HAD MISUSED ITS NEUTRALITY TO INFILTRATE "GREEN BERETS" INTO CZECHO-  
SLOVAKIA DISGUISED AS TOURISTS, IT WAS OFFICIALLY ANNOUNCED IN VIENNA  
THURSDAY.

THE ORIGINAL CHARGE BY THE MOSCOW "LITERATURNAYA GAZETA" CLAIMED  
THAT UNITS OF THE U.S. 6TH ARMY ALONG WITH SPECIAL TROOPS OF THE WEST  
GERMAN ARMY ENTERED CZECHOSLOVAKIA "DISGUISED AS TOURISTS."

IT SAID THE TROOPS, SPEAKING CZECH OR SLOVAK, HAD COME TO SALZBURG  
SOMETIME IN JULY AND THEN HAD DONNED CIVILIAN ATTIRE AND WENT TO  
CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE AUSTRIAN DEFENSE MINISTRY ALSO DENIED THE REPORTS IN AN ANNOUNCE-  
MENT LAST EVENING.

C/S NATIONAL FRONT COMMITTEES OFFICIALS TO MEET ON SEPTEMBER 3  
MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD)--THE SECRETARIAT OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE OF THE  
CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL FRONT HAS DEMANDED THE CHAIRMEN AND SECRETARIES  
OF THE REGIONAL NATIONAL FRONT COMMITTEES FROM ALL OVER THE COUNTRY TO  
ATTEND A MEETING AT THE NATIONAL FRONT'S SECRETARIAT IN PRAGUE ON --  
SEPTEMBER 3, AT 1000 HOURS M.T., RADIO LEGAL CENTRAL BOHEMIA  
REPORTED LAST NIGHT.

C/S TELEVISION STILL OCCUPIED, NO RPT NO TELECAST AS YET  
MUNICH, AUG. 29 (CMD)--CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION IS STILL UNABLE TO  
START ITS TRANSMISSIONS BECAUSE ITS STUDIOS ARE OCCUPIED BY MILITARY  
GROUPS, RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA REPORTED LAST NIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID ANY REPORTS SAYING THAT THE TELEVISION TRANSMISSION  
WILL START AS EARLY AS LAST NIGHT "ARE NOT RPT NOT BASED ON TRUTH," AND  
IT ADDED THAT "THE BEGINNING OF CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION TRANSMISSIONS  
WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN TIME."

THE RADIO ALSO REPORTED THAT "ACCORDING TO THE INFORMATION OF THE  
NATIONAL ENTERPRISE BENZINA, IN STRASNICE (PRAGUE DISTRICT), THE  
SUPPLIES OF PETROL ARE NORMAL IN PRAGUE AND THE CENTRAL BOHEMIAN REGIONS."

THE RADIO SAID THE MEASURES HAVE BEEN ABOLISHED WHICH ONLY ALLOWED  
10 LITRES OF PETROL TO BE SOLD TO PRIVATE DRIVERS.
