X/4 C/S -- RADIO STATIONS GO OFF THE AIR

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD)-OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO STATIONS MONITORED IN MUNICH, FOUR "FREE LEGAL" SLOVAK STATIONS WENT OFF THE AIR THURSDAY, WHILE THE POWERFUL TRANSMITTER OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA ONE AND TRASMITTERS FOR SOUTH MORAVIA WERE NT RPT NOT HEARD AT ALL.

THE FOLLOWING STUDIOS RPT STUDIOS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO , MOST OF WHICH IDENTIFIED THEMSELVES AS "FREE LEGAL" RADIOS, WERE ON THE AIR IN BOHEMIA AND MORAVIA THURSDAY OVER A CENTRAL HOOKUP:

CENTRAL BOHEMIA , PRAGUE, CZECHOSLOVAKIA ONE (STUDIO), WESTERN BOHEMIA, EASTERN BOHEMIA, SOUTHERN BOHEMIA, SOUTHERN MORAVIA RADIO BRNO, AND NORTHERN MORAVIA.

A STATION OF CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION WHICH IDENTIFIED ITSELF AS THE FREE STUDIO OSTRAVA BEGAN BROADCASTING AT 1900 MT THURSDAY AND SAID IT IS TO BROADCAST ON FRIDAY AT 1200, 1700 AND 1900 MT.

RADIO BRNO SAID IT WILL BEGAN BROADCASTING FRIDAY AT 1000 . THE DIRECTOR OF THE RADIO ASKED THE EMPLOYEES TO REPORT TO WORK AS THE RADIO BUILDING IS NOW FREE.

ALL TRANSMITTERS WHICH UP TO NOW WORKED FOR SOUTHERN MORAVIA WENT OFF THE AIR IN THE NIGHT FROM WEDNESDAY TO THURSDAY.

IN SLOVAKIA ONLY THE "FREE LEGAL" RADIO "ON THE DANUBE" AND "CENTRAL SLOVAKIA" WERE ON THE AIR BETWEEN 1300 AND 2400 MT.
