

## BARRACKS IN SLOVAK TOWN OCCUPIED

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD)-SOVIET TROOPS HAVE ENTERED BY FORCE A BARRACKS AT OZDANY, SOUTHERN SLOVAKIA, RADIO CENTRAL SLOVAKIA REPORTED LAST NIGHT.

THE RADIO SAID THE SOVIET TROOPS DID SO DESPITE TALKS WITH THE COMMAND OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK UNIT.

IN SPITE OF THE UNIT COMMAND PROTEST, THE SOVIET TROOPS LEFT THEIR GUARDS THERE "ALLEGEDLY TO OPPOSE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY FORCES," THE RADIO SAID.

## RUSSIANS CALL OFF INT'L CONGRESS

STOCKHOLM, AUG 30 (RFE SPECIAL/THRANE)-AN INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS FOR DOCUMENTATION WHICH SHOULD HAVE TAKEN PLACE IN MOSCOW ON SEPT 9-18 HAS BEEN CANCELLED "BECAUSE OF UNEXPECTED EVENTS", ACCORDING TO A TELEGRAM RECEIVED FROM MOSCOW BY THE SWEDISH NATIONAL COMMITTEE FOR DOCUMENTATION AND THE TECHNICAL LITERATURE SOCIETY YESTERDAY.

THE 23 SWEDISH DELEGATES WHO WERE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CONGRESS HAD ALREADY ANNOUNCED THEIR REFUSAL TO GO TO THE SOVIET UNION AFTER THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA. DELEGATES FROM THE OTHER SCANDINAVIAN COUNTRIES HAD DONE THE SAME.

## CUBA WILL NOT ATTEND NON-PROLIFERATION CONFERENCE

P-10 MIAMI, AUG 30 (RFE SPECIAL/VOLSKY)--THE CASTRO REGIME HAS ANNOUNCED IT WILL NOT REPEAT NO TAKE PART IN THE CONFERENCE ON THE NONPROLIFERATION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN GENEVA WHICH OPENED YESTERDAY.

THE HAVANA RADIO SAID YESTERDAY THAT CUBA'S FOREIGN MINISTER RAUL ROAD HAD SENT A NOTE TO UNITED NATIONS SECRETARY GENERAL U THANT STATING THAT IN "COMPLETE ACCORDANCE WITH THE CLEAR POSITION ASSUMED BY CUBA, THIS COUNTRY WILL NOT RPT NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE CONFERENCE OF NON-NUCLEAR STATES."

ON SEVERAL RECENT OCCASIONS, FIDEL CASTRO HAS DENOUNCED THE NONPROLIFERATION TREATY UNDER DISCUSSION BY THE UNITED STATES, THE SOVIET UNION AND A NUMBER OF OTHER COUNTRIES AS INCOMPATIBLE WITH CUBAN NATIONAL INTEREST.

## DAYAN UNSATISFIED

JERUSALEM, AUG 30 REUTER - ISRAEL'S DEFENCE MINISTER, GENERAL MOSHE DAYAN, LAST NIGHT DESCRIBED AS "MOST UNSATISFACTORY" A REPLY BROUGHT BACK FROM CAIRO BY A UNITED NATIONS OFFICIAL ABOUT THE AMBUSH OF AN ISRAELI JEEP ON THE EAST BANK OF THE SUEZ CANAL.

HE WAS SPEAKING TO REPORTERS AFTER MEETING THE U.N. CHIEF CEASEFIRE OBSERVER, LIEUTENANT-GENERAL ODD BULL, ON THE GENERALS RETURN FROM CAIRO WHERE HE WAS REPORTED TO HAVE HAD TALKS WITH THE UNDER-SECRETARY AT THE FOREIGN MINISTRY, MR. SALAH GOHAR.

TWO ISRAELI SOLDIERS WERE KILLED IN THE AMBUSH ON MONDAY NIGHT AND ANOTHER IS MISSING.

GENERAL DAYAN, WHO ALSO SAW GENERAL BULL ON TUESDAY BEFORE HE LEFT FOR CAIRO, SAID THE REPLY ABOUT THE MISSING SOLDIER "WAS ALSO NOT ENCOURAGING."

HE SAID ISRAEL HAD ASKED THE INTERNATIONAL RED CROSS TO MAKE FULL INQUIRIES ABOUT THE SOLDIER.
