X/4 C/S -- CSSR MISSION STATEMENT QUOTED (RELEADS CN 7)

MUNICH, AUGUST 30 -- (CMD) -- THE CZECHOSLOVAK DIPLOMATIC MISSION IN VIENNA HAS SAID THAT FOUR CZECHOSLOVAK MINISTERS NOW OUTSIDE THE COUNTRY PLAN TO LEAVE FOR CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

IN AN ENGLISH-LANGUAGE BROADCAST LAST NIGHT, RADIO PRAGUE SAID (TEXT):

CZECHOSLOVAK DEPUTY PREMIER OTA SIK AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT, PROFESSOR TROKAN, FRANTISEK VLASAK, AND STEFAN GASPARIK, WHO WERE STRANDED IN YUGOSLAVIA ON 21 TWENTYONE AUGUST, ACCORDING TO AFP RPT AFP HAVE LEFT BELGRADE FOR VIENNA.

"CZECHOSLOVAK FOREIGN MINISTER JIRI HAJEK, WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY LEFT FOR VIENNA BY PLANE, HAS HAD TALKS AT THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS.

"ACCORDING TO A STATEMENT ISSUED BY THE CZECHOSLOVAK DIPLOMATIC MISSION IN VIENNA, THE FOUR MINISTERS INTEND TO LEAVE FOR CZECHOSLOVAKIA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
