X/4 C/S -- SOVIET-SUPPORTED RADIO ATTACKS EDITORS

MUNICH, AUGUST 30 --(CMD) -- A NEW SOVIET SUPPORTED RADIO STATION IN THE CSSR LAST NIGHT STRONGLY ATTACKED SEVERAL CZECHOSLOVAK JOURNALISTS WHOSE SLOGAN, IT CLAIMED, HAS BEEN "DEMOCRACY FOR AGITATORS."

THE TRANSMITTER CALLING ITSELF "ZARE" (GLOWS) REFERRED TO THE JANUARY PLENUM OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK CENTRAL COMMITTEE AND THEN CLAIMED THAT NOT ALL PEOPLE HAD THE SAME INTENTIONS WHEN THEY ENTERED THE ROAD OF BUILDING A "NEW HUMANISTIC SOCIETY."

"UNDER THE SLOGAN OF DEMOCRACY, RENAISSANCE AND HUMANISM, EDITORS AND PUBLICISTS BEGAN TO APPEAR OF WHOM NOTHING COULD BE HEARD UNTIL THAT TIME OR WHO SIGNED ARTICLES ASSESSING POSITIVELY THE POLICY OF (FORMER CZECHOSLOVAK PARTY LEADER ANTONIN) NOVOTNY.
