X/4 C/S -- NEVER REPEAT MOVE, PAPER SAYS

MUNICH, AUGUST 39 (CMD) -- THE YUGOSLAV TRADE UNION WEEKLY RAD, HAS SAID THAT THE MILITARY OPERATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA MUST NEVER HAPPEN AGAIN.

IT ALSO SAID THAT THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT REACHED BETWEEN THE SOVIET UNION AND CZECHOSLOVAKIA SHOULD SERVE AS THE INITIAL STEP FOR THE SOLUTION OF PROBLEMS WHICH LED TO THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

THE YUGOSLAV NEWS AGENCY TANJUG TODAY CARRIED THE FOLLOWING REPORT: "THE BELGRADE WEEKLY RAD POINTS OUT IN ITS COMMENTARY DEVOTED TO CZECHOSLOVAKIA, MUST NEVER HAPPEN AGAIN NOT RPT NOT ONLY BECAUSE THIS IS IN THE INTEREST OF THOSE WHO RUSHED INTO IT, BUT ALSO BECAUSE IT IS IN THE INTEREST OF PEACE AND PROGRESS IN THE WORLD.

"THE LESSON LIES ALSO IN THE FACT THAT THERE IS NO RPT NO OTHER ROAD FOR CZECHOSLOVAKIA EXCEPT THAT OF DEMOCRATIC SOCIALISM, ALONG WHICH IS SET OUT AFTER JANUARY.

"IT WOULD BE DANGEROUS IF THAT ROAD, THE ONLY ONE THAT CAN MAINTAIN BELIEF IN THE IDEALS OF SOCIALISM, WERE JEOPARDIZED BY EXCESSES OR PRESSURE.

"THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT, THE ORGAN OF THE YUGOSLAV TRADE UNIONS WRITES, SHOULD SERVE AS THE INITIAL STEP IN THE SOLUTION OF PROBLEMS AND THE REMOVAL OF THE ROOTS AND ERRORS WHICH LED TO OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AS WELL AS IN THE LIQUIDATION OF ITS CONSEQUENCES."
