HE ADDED THAT EVERY CONTACT BETWEEN THE POPULATION AND THE POLISH TROOPS IS DESCRIBED AS COLLABORATION.

"DIFFERENT KINDS OF HARASSMENTS AND REPRESSIONS ARE APPLIED TOWARD THE HEALTHY COMMUNIST ELEMENTS.

"I HAVE TALKED TODAY WITH A CZECHOSLOAK WORKER," SAID THE CORRESPONDENT, "WHOSE BROTHER WAS HEAVILY BEATEN FOR OFFERING TO THE POLISH SOLDIERS SEVERAL TANKARDS OF BEER.

"A GIRL WHO EXCHANGED SEVERAL WORDS WITH THE POLISH SOLDIERS YESTERDAY HAD HER HAIR CUT OFF. SLOGANS THREATEN WITH IMPRISONMENT AND EVEN DEATH FOR THE CONTACTS WITH THE POLES, WHICH ARE DESCRIBED AS COLLABORATION.

"IT IS NOT DIFFICULT TO GUESS THAT THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION IN THE CZECHOSLOVAK SOCIALIST REPUBLIC HAS STAKED ON THE INTIMIDATION OF THE POPULATION," SAID THE CORRESPONDENT.

HE ADDED THAT IN THESE CONDITIONS IT WAS VERY DIFFICULT TO PRESENT THE TRUTH TO "PEOPLE MISLED BY MAD PROPAGANDA".

"THIS IS A COMPLEX PROCESS AND CANNOT BE IMPLEMENTED IN SEVERAL DAYS," HE SAID.
