WORLD - THE DAY AHEAD

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CNR) -- THE CZECHOSLOVAK SITUATION AND THE AFTERMATH OF THE DEMOCRATIC CONVENTION TOP THE NEWS THIS MORNING.

TENSION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA APPEARS TO HAVE EASED AND LIFE IS RETURNING TO NORMAL IN PRAGUE. CZECHOSLOVAKS HAVE BEEN WARNED NOT TO TAKE PART IN RALLIES, DEMONSTRATIONS OR ASSEMBLIES OR RISK PROVOCATION.

THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY CONVENTION WINDS UP ITS FINAL SESSION EARLY TODAY WITH ACCEPTANCE SPEECHES BY PRESIDENTIAL NOMINEE HUBERT HUMPHREY AND THE VICE-PRESIDENTIAL NOMINEE, EXPECTED TO BE HUMPHREY'S CHOICE, MAINE SENATOR EDMUND MUSKIE. THE CONVENTION MUST ENDORSE THE CHOICE BY BALLOT.

IN GENEVA, THE CONFERENCE OF SOME 80 NON-NUCLEAR COUNTRIES WHICH OPENED YESTERDAY, CONTINUES TODAY.
