X/4 C/S -- OFFICIAL TANJUG COMMENTARY ON MOSCOW AGREEMENT

BELGRADE, AUGUST 30 (CMD) -- TANJUG SAID LAST NIGHT IN A COMMENTARY ON THE MOSCOW AGREEMENT BETWEEN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND THE SOVIET UNION THAT THE AGREEMENT WOULD ONLY HELP OVERCOME "THE DIFFICULT SITUATION IN THE HEART OF EUROPE" IF THE "JUST REQUEST OF THE PEOPLES OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA" WERE MET.

TANJUG SAID THAT THE SOLUTION OF THE SITUATION ALSO NECESSITATED MEETING THE "JUST REQUESTS" OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK COMMUNIST PARTY. ALSO NEEDED HERE THE "WITHDRAWAL OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE FIVE COUNTRIES, NON-INTERFERENCE INTO INTERNAL AFFAIRS, THE RIGHT TO INDEPENDENCE AND SOVEREIGNTY AND TO ONE'S OWN PATH OF DEVELOPMENT OF SOCIALISM."

TANJUG SAID WHETHER OR NOT THESE CONDITIONS WERE MET WOULD HAVE A BEARING ON THE SITUATION IN EUROPE "AND THE INTERNATIONAL WORKERS MOVEMENT, WITH ALL THE CONSEQUENCES WHICH THAT SITUATION BEARS FOR PEACE AND RELATIONS IN THE WORLD..."

THE OFFICIAL YUGOSLAV NEWS AGENCY OPENED ITS COMMENTARY WITH THE STATEMENT "SOCIALIST YUGOSLAVIA HAS ALWAYS STARTED FROM THE PRINCIPLE THAT CONFLICTS AMONG THE STATES SHOULD BE SETTLED ON THE BASIS OF EQUALITY WITH RESPECT FOR THEIR SOVEREIGNTY AND NON-INTERFERENCE INTO INTERNAL AFFAIRS, BY THE ACCORDS AND NOT BY THE USE OF FORCE."
