X/4 C/S -- OCCUPATION DAMAGE GO TO 80 MILLION CROWNS A DAY

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD) -- RADIO DANUBE SAID THIS MORNING THAT ECONOMISTS "ASSESS THE LOSSES CAUSED TO THE CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL ECONOMY BY FOREIGN TROOPS AT 60 TO 80 MILLION CROWNS DAILY."

THE RADIO ADDED THAT THE "COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY, ROADS, THE SUPPLY OF GOODS AND TRANSPORT ARE MOSTLY AFFECTED."

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO, "THE CONSEQUENCES OF THE IMPAIRED SUPPLY OF GOODS CANNOT RPT CANNOT BE ASSESSED EXACTLY STILL TODAY."

THE FULL TEXT OF THE RADIO DANUBE COMMENT FOLLOWS:

"DEAR FRIENDS:

TO SPEAK NOW ABOUT MATERIAL LOSSES WHEN OUR NATIONS HAVE EXPERIENCED SUCH A BITTER DISAPPOINTMENT, WHEN VAST DAMAGE WAS CAUSED TO THE IDEALS AND PRINCIPLES, CAN SEEM TO YOU AS NARROW-MINDEDNESS.

"WELL, THE MATERIAL LOSSES ARE A MOTOR, THE WHEELS OF WHICH ARE TURNING IN THE OPPOSITE DIRECTION.

"IT IS A PITY, BUT EVEN THE LOSSES CAUSED TO THE NATIONAL ECONOMY BELONG TO THE PICTURE OF CUREL REALITY; THE ECONOMISTS AND EVEN SIMPLE PEOPLE TRY TO EVALUATE THE LOSSES WHICH ARE 'NOT RPT NOT SMALL'.

'YESTERDAY I HEARD AN EXCITED PERSON SPEAKING AT GOTTWALD SQUARE ABOUT A 30 MILLION (CROWN) LOSS INFLICTED ON THE INSTALLATIONS IN THE BUILDING OF THE NEW POST OFFICE."
