"LET US BELIEVE WE WILL LIQUIDATE THE LOSSES AND THE OBSTACLES AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AND THAT OUR ENTIRE LIFE WILL BECOME CONSOLIDATED. OF COURSE, ONLY IF IT WILL BE MADE SINCERELY POSSIBLE FOR US, BECAUSE IT IS DIFFICULT TO ELIMINATE THE CONSEQUENCES IF THE CAUSES PREVAIL," RADIO DANUBE SAID.
