MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD) -- THE BELGRADE DAILY, BORBA, TODAY REFERRED TO AN ARTICLE IN THE WARSAW DAILY, ZYCIE WARSZAWY, ON "ALLEGED MISTREATMENT OF POLISH TOURISTS STAYING IN YUGOSLAVIA DURING THE CZECHOSLOVAK EVENTS."

RADIO ZAGREX QUOTED BORBA AS SAYING THAT "OF ALL ALLEGED INCIDENTS INVOLVING OUR CITIZENS AND TOURISTS FROM SOME EASTERN COUNTRIES ONLY TWO OR THREE CASES OF OPEN PROVOCATIONS ARE KNOWN, WHICH REMAINED, HOWEVER, WITHOUT UNDESIRE CONSEQUENCES ONLY THANKS TO THE DISCIPLINE OF OUR PEOPLE.

"EVEN IN THOSE SEVERAL UNPLEASANT SITUATIONS, THE HIGH CONSCIENCE OF OUR CITIZENS WAS MIRRORED. DESPITE THE PROVOCATIVE BEHAVIOR OF INDIVIDUAL FOREIGNERS FROM SOME OF THE EASTERN COUNTRIES OUR CITIZENS KNOW THAT THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA
