INVASION CUTS SWEDISH TOURISTS TO POLAND

STOCKHOLM, AUG 30 -- (RFE SPECIAL/HENRY) -- A LEADING SWEDISH SHIPPING AGENT IN YSTAD STATED TODAY THAT THE "EVENTS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAVE HAD A NEGATIVE EFFECT ON THE FERRY TRAFFIC BETWEEN YSTAD AND POLAND."

SHIPPING AGENT ULF JARL OF YSTAD SAID THAT NORMALLY AT THIS TIME OF YEAR ABOUT 100 PERSONS TRAVEL SOUTH VIA THE FERRY EACH DAY, AND CURRENTLY ONLY ABOUT 50 ARE DOING SO. CARGO LOADS HAVE NOT BEEN AFFECTED, HOWEVER, HE SAID.

AGENT JARL SAID "IT WAS NOT UNTIL TWO DAYS AFTER FIRST NEWS OF THE INVASION THAT THERE WAS ANY EFFECT ON THE PASSENGER LIST. THEREAFTER, THE STREAM OF TRAVELLERS REDUCED STEADILY. BUT WE HOPE AS THE SITUATION ON CZECHOSLOVAKIA BECOMES MORE STABLE, THE BOOKINGS ON THE FERRY WILL INCREASE."

DANES CANCEL FOOTBALL MATCH AGAINST POLAND

STOCKHOLM, AUG 30 -- (RFE SPECIAL/HENRY) -- THE DANISH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION YESTERDAY DECIDED TO CALL OFF ITS SCHEDULED NATIONAL MATCH AGAINST POLAND OCT. 16, AND SAID IT WAS UNCERTAIN WHETHER MATCHES AGAINST CZECHOSLOVAKIA SEPT. 25 HERE AND IN OCTOBER IN BRATISLAVA.

THE ASSOCIATION SAID "IN CONNECTION WITH THE DANISH ATHLETIC UNIONS APPEAL NOT TO PARTICIPATE IN ARRANGEMENTS WITH THE SOVIET UNION AND ITS ALLIES WHO INVADED CZECHOSLOVAKIA, WE ARE CALLING OFF THE MATCH AGAINST POLAND." /V
