X/4C/S -- RADIO BRNO RESUMES BROADCASTS

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD) -- RADIO BRNO TODAY BROADCASTS ITS OLD IDENTIFICATION SIGNAL AT 1126 MT FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE THE OCCUPATION.

THE RADIO RESUMED BROADCASTING ON VERY HIGH FREQUENCY 71.87 MEGACYCLES WITH REGIONAL NEWS AT 1000 MT TODAY.

THE BRNO-MEDIUM-WAVE TRANSMITTER ON 953 KILOCYCLES IS ON THE AIR WITHIN THE FRAMEWORK OF THE NATIONAL HOOK-UP.

RADIO PRAGUE ANNOUNCED AT 0521 MT THIS MORNING THAT RADIO BRNO WOULD BROADCAST REGIONAL NEWS AT 1000 MT.

THE ANNOUNCEMENT ADDED THAT THE DIRECTOR OF RADIO BRNO "COMRADE JURASEK ASKS ALL EMPLOYEES TO RETURN TO WORK TODAY SINCE THE RADIO STATION'S BUILDING HAS ALREADY BEEN VACATED" (BY THE OCCUPATION FORCES).

THE FOLLOWING RADIO STATIONS ARE PARTICIPATING IN THE NATIONAL HOOK-UP:

RADIO PRAGUE, CZECHOSLOAKIA, ONE CENTRAL BOHEMIA, SOUTHERN BOHEMIA, WESTERN BOHEMIA, NORTHERN BOHEMIA, EASTERN BOHEMIA, SOUTHERN MORAVIA, NORTHERN MORAVIA, PRAGUE ON VERY HIGH FREQUENCY OF 69 TO 71 MEGACYCLES, AND FROM TIME TO TIME HRADEC KRALOVE BROADCASTING ON SHORT WAVE IN THE 49, 41, 31, AND 25 METER BANDS AND IN SLOVAKIA RADIO DANUBE AND THE TOWN OF CORN BROADCASTING IN HUNGARIAN FOR THE HUNGARIAN MINORITY IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA.

RADIO HRADEC KRALOVE BROADCASTING ON SHORT WAVES ALSO CARRIES PROGRAMS IN FOREIGN LANGUAGES. THE TELEVISION TRANSMITTERS PRAGUE AND OSTRAVA WERE ALSO HEARD YESTERDAY.
