

X/4 C/S -- GOVERNMENT MEETS TO DISCUSS PRAGUE SITUATION

MUNICH, AUG. 30 (CMD) -- RADIO CZECHOSLOVAK ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT A GOVERNMENT SESSION HAD BEGUN AT 0900 MT TO "DISCUSS A REPORT ON THE SITUATION IN PRAGUE."

THE RADIO SAID PREMIER OLDRICH CERNIK WAS CHAIRMAN .

THE RADIO ADDED THAT THE SESSION WOULD ALSO DISCUSS "OTHER MEASURES TO BE TAKEN TOWARD A NORMALIZATION OF LIFE IN OUR COUNTRY. AFTER THE GOVERNMENT MEETING, AN OVERALL, DETAILED REPORT WILL BE PUBLISHED."

THE RADIO CONTINUED:

"IN THIS CONNECTION, WE WOULD DRAW YOUR ATTENTION TO THE FACT THAT REPRESENTATIVES OF THE COMMAND OF FOREIGN TROOPS UNITS IN PRAGUE TODAY ANNOUNCED TO CZECHOSLOVAK ORGANS THAT, PROVIDED THAT SLOGANS, INSCRIPTIONS AND POSTERS IN THE CAPITAL ARE REMOVED, THE TROOPS WILL LEAVE THE TERRITORY OF THE CAPITAL. HENCE WE APPEAL TO ALL CITIZENS OF PRAGUE FOR HELP IN PUTTING THE CAPITAL IN ORDER. (RADIO CZECHOSLOVAK IN CZECH, BROADCASTING FROM CENTRAL BOHEMIA/F 1216 AUG. 30)
