X/4 C/S -- OFFICIAL REPORT SAYS 20 KILLED IN SLOVAKIA

MUNICH, AUG. 30 (CMD) -- THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL MET TODAY AND HEARD OFFICIAL REPORTS, INCLUDING ONE WHICH SAID 20 PERSONS WERE KILLED DURING AND AFTER THE RECENT INVASION OF SLOVAKIA. SEVERAL DOZEN WERE INJURED.

THE COUNCIL'S MEETING WAS REPORTED BY RADIO FREE DANUBE, WHICH SAID 65 OF THE COUNCIL'S 92 MEMBERS WERE IN ATTENDANCE.

THE RADIO SAID IT WAS UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF ONDREJ KLOKOC, ITS REGULAR CHAIRMAN, WHO SPOKE OF THE DIFFICULT SITUATION IN WHICH THE COUNTRY FOUND ITSELF. HE SAID "WE SHALL HAVE TO SEEK WAYS AND THREADS TO THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES BECAUSE THE FUTURE OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA CANNOT BE IMAGINED OUTSIDE THE SOCIALIST CAMP," ACCORDING TO THIS RADIO STATION.

HE ALSO ASKED THE SLOVAK NATIONAL COUNCIL TO ADOPT A STANDPOINT REGARDING THE OPINION OF THOSE WHO BELIEVE THERE IS A NEED TO APPEAL TO THE UNITED NATIONS.
