

"CONSOLIDATION THE BEST WEAPON", SAYS PAPER

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD)- THE SLOVAK DAILY LUD SAID IN A COMMENTARY TODAY "WE MUST WORK AND PROVE THAT THE SITUATION IN OUR COUNTRY IS NORMAL", RADIO DANUBE REPORTED.

"LET US DEMONSTRATE THAT WE HAVE NO GRUDGE AGAINST THE NATIONS OF THE ARMIES WHICH INVADED US; WE ARE ONLY AGAINST THE PEOPLE WHO SENT THEM," THE PAPER SAID.

CSSR RESUMES COMMERCIAL RELATIONS

PARIS, AUG 30 (UPI)-THE CZECHOSLOVAK EMBASSY IN PARIS TODAY ANNOUNCED THAT COMMERCIAL RELATIONS BETWEEN CZECHOSLOVAKIA AND OTHER COUNTRIES HAD OFFICIALLY RESUMED.

AN EMBASSY COMMUNIQUE SAID CZECHOSLOVAKIA WOULD HONOR ALL CONTRACTS FOR EXPORTS AND WAS APPEALLING TO OTHER NATIONS "TO RESUME THEIR DELIVERIES (OF IMPORTS) AS RAPIDLY AS POSSIBLE."

THE INTERNATIONAL FAIR OF BRNO, SCHEDULED FOR SEPT 8-15, MAY BE POSTPONED FOR A WEEK, BUT WILL STILL TAKE PLACE, THE EMBASSY SAID, APPEALING THAT IT BE "ITS USUAL SUCCESS" AS A FORUM FOR EAST-WEST CONTACTS.

TOKYO DEMONSTRATION AGAINST RED ARMY CHORUS

TOKYO, AUG. 30, REUTER -- ABOUT 50 PEOPLE DEMONSTRATED IN FRONT OF THE OFFICES OF THE YOMIURI SHIMBUN, ONE OF JAPANS LARGEST NEWSPAPERS, TODAY AGAINST THE VISIT OF A SOVIET ARMY CHORUS GROUP.

THE GROUP, SPONSORED BY THE NEWSPAPER, ARE SCHEDULED TO ARRIVE HERE ON SEPTEMBER 27 FOR A ONE MONTH TOUR. ONE MAN WHO TRIED TO FORCE HIS WAY INTO THE BUILDING WITH A BURNING SMOKE BOMB WAS ARRESTED.
