X/4 C/S -- 2ND ADD IZVESTIA DESCRIBES (CN 196) XXX UNDERSTANDING

IN ITS OWN REPORT DESCRIBING THE SITUATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, TASS SAID TONIGHT EVERY PASSING DAYS "BRINGS NEW PROOF OF THE GREAT IMPORTANCE OF THE DECISIONS TAKEN AS A RESULT OF THE SOVIET-CZECHOSLOVAK TALKS IN MOSCOW."

TASS SAID WHAT IT CALLED CLANDESTINE RADIO TRANSMITTERS "ARE LESS ACTIVE," AND THAT THE NORMAL WORK OF THE PRESS HAS NOT RPT NOT BEEN RESTORED SO FAR.

TASS THEN SAID:

"IN THE CONDITIONS OF THE RESTORATION OF ORDER IN THE COUNTRY THE ANTIPOPULAR ELEMENTS FIND IT INCREASINGLY DIFFICULT TO CONTINUE THEIR OVERT SUBVERSIVE ACTIVITIES, TO DECEIVE THE POPULATION AND ARRANGE PROVOCATIONS.

"THE TACTICS OF THE COUNTER REVOLUTIONARIES ARE DEFINITELY CHANGING. THE ENEMIES OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE AND ALL ANTISOCIALIST FORCES ARE MAKING STRAINUOUS ATTEMPTS TO ORGANIZE STRUGGLE AGAINST THE DECISIONS JOINTLY WORKED OUT AS A RESULT OF THE SOVIET CZECHOSLOVAK TALKS IN MOSCOW AND AGAINST THE MEASURES THE PARTY AND THE GOVERNMENT ARE TAKING TO CARRY THEM INTO LIFE.
