X/4 C/S - BRATISLAVA MAYOR PLEDGE

MUNICH, AUGUST 30 (CMD)- RADIO DANUBE REPORTED TODAY THAT BRATISLAVA MAYOR HLADKY HAS GIVEN A PLEDGE TO THE GOVERNMENT TO KEEP PUBLIC ORDER AS ONE OF THE CONDITIONS FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF FOREIGN TROOPS FROM THE SLOVAK CAPITAL.

HE SAID THAT THREE-MAN PATROLS IN THE CITY WILL CONSIST OF A MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL SECURITY (POLICE), A MEMBER OF THE ARMY, AND A MEMBER OF THE MILITIA.

THE PATROLS WILL BE UNIFORMED, THE RADIO SAID.
