

LUXEMBOURG ENVOY NOT RETURNING TO MOSCOW

LUXEMBOURG, AUG.30, REUTER -LUXEMBOURG HAS ORDERED ITS AMBASSADOR TO MOSCOW NOT TO RETURN TO HIS POST UNTIL THE CZECHOSLOVAK CRISIS SIMMERS DOWN, FOREIGN MINISTER PIERRE GREGOIRE SAID TODAY.

LUXEMBOURG HAS CONDEMNED THE SOVIET INVASION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, BUT ITS TINY COMMUNIST PARTY IS ONE OF THE FEW IN THE WESTERN WORLD TO GIVE MOSCOW ITS WHOLEHEARTED SUPPORT DURING THE CRISIS.

M. GREGOIRE TOLD THE NEWSPAPER LUZEMBURGER WORT IN AN INTERVIEW THAT HIS GOVERNMENT PLANNED NO IMMEDIATE CHANGES IN ITS DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH MOSCOW.

A NATIONAL OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, HE WAS BORN IN 1924 AND JOINED THE UNITED NATIONS IN 1962. BEFORE THAT TIME HE HELD A NUMBER OF JOURNALISTIC POSTIONS IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA, INCLUDING THAT OF A CORRESPONDENT OF CZECHOSLOVAK RADIO IN MOSCOW.

BONN CANCELS TROOP LEAVE

BONN, AUG 30, REUTER - THE WEST GERMAN ARMY HAS CANCELLED WEEK-END LEAVE FOR THE SECOND WEEK RUNNING BECAUSE OF THE WARSAW PACT OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, A DEFENCE MINISTRY SPOKESMAN SAID HERE TODAY.
