X/4 C/S -- HUNGARIAN CABINET SAYS HOARDING GROUNDLESS

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD)-- THE HUNGARIAN COUNCIL OF MINISTERS HAS STATED THAT SUPPLY IN THE COUNTRY HAS BEEN UNDISTURBED IN SPITE OF GROUNDLESS HOARDING , RADIO BUDAPEST REPORTED TONIGHT.

(CMD -- HUNGARIAN PREMIER JENOE FOCK REPORTED YESTERDAY TO THE CABINET ON "THE RECENT MOSCOW TALKS OF THE PARTY AND GOVERNMENT DELEGATIONS OF THE FIVE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES.")

ACCORDING TO THE RADIO THE CABINET WHICH MET THURSDAY STRESSED THAT THE HUNGARIAN TROOPS BEING "TEMPORARILY" IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA ARE "FULFILLING THEIR TASK HONESTLY AND WITH GREAT POLITICAL WILLINGNESS."

"THEY ARE CONSISTENTLY SPARING NO TROUBLES TO ESTABLISH GOOD COOPERATION WITH THE LOCAL PARTY AND STATE ORGANS, CZECHOSLOVAK ARMY UNITS AND THE PEOPLE IN THE INTEREST OF DEFENDING THE SOCIALIST ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE," THE COUNCIL SAID.

IT STATED THERE WERE NO RPT NO ARMED FIGHTS OR INDIVIDUAL AND FINANCIAL LOSSES IN THE DISTRICTS WHERE THE HUNGARIAN UNITS ARE STATIONED.

. THE HUNGARIAN TROOPS ARE FULLY SUPPLIED BY HUNGARY, THE COUNCIL STATED. IT SAID AFTER TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS RAILWAY TRAFFIC RESUMED REGULAR OPERATION.
