SOVIETS FREE COMMUNICATIONS IN BRATISLAVA

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD)-- THE SOVIET TROOPS HAVE EVACUATED THE TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH OFFICES IN BRATISLAVA, RADIO DANUBE REPORTED TONIGHT.

SOVIET MILITARY AUTHORITIES HAD PROMISED THAT FRIDAY AFTERNOON INTERNATIONAL TELEPHONE TRAFFIC WOULD BE RESUMED, THE RADIO SAID.

"UNFORTUNATELY WE ARE UNABLE TO VERIFY THE AUTHENTICITY OF THIS REPORT. OUR TELEPHONES DO NOT RPT NOT FUNCTION SO FAR," THE RADIO ADDED. (RADIO DANUBE, M, AUG 30, 1920)

CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION STILL PARTLY OCCUPIED

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD)-- SOME STUDIOS, TRANSMITTERS, AND BUILDINGS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK TELEVISION ARE STILL OCCUPIED BY THE MILITARY, RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA SAID TONIGHT.

FOR THIS REASON THE TELEVISION STUDIO PRAGUE HAS BEEN SO FAR UNABLE TO RESUME NORMAL ACTIVITIES, THE REPORT ADDED. (RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA, AUG 30, 1918)
