X/4 C/S -- 1ST ADD CENSORSHIP MOVES ANNOUNCED

(CN 225) XXX INFORMATION

IN A REPORT ABOUT TODAY'S MEETING OF THE GOVERNMENT, THE RADIO SAID:

"... IN VIEW OF THE PRESENT EXTRAORDINARY SITUATION IN OUR COUNTRY ... THE GOVERNMENT DEEMS IT NECESSARY TO ADOPT EXTRAORDINARY MEASURES FOR THE CONTROL OF MASS INFORMATION MEDIA.

"THEREFORE IT HAD ALREADY ENTRUSTED THE MINISTRY OF CULTURE AND INFORMATION AND THE MINISTRY OF JUSTICE WITHOUT DELAY TO PREPARE A DRAFT LAW AMENDMENT OF EXTRAORDINARY MEASURE IN THE SPHERE OF THE PRESS RADIO AND TELEVISION.

"IN VIEW OF THE NECESSITY OF THE IMMEDIATE SOLUTION OF THE SITUATION, THE GOVERNMENT IS ESTABLISHING AT THE GOVERNMENT PRESIDUM FOR THE DIRECTING BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PRESS, RADIO AND TELEVISION AND CETEKA AN OFFICE FOR PRESS AND INFORMATION HEADED BY A DIRECTOR NOMINATED BY THE GOVERNMENT.

"IT IS THE TASK OF THIS OFFICE UNIFORMLY TO STANDARDIZE AND CONTROL THE ACTIVITY OF THE PRESS, RADIO TELEVISION AND CETEKA, AND SIMULTANEOUSLY TO WORK AS AN INFORMATION AND CONSULTATION CENTER OF THE PRESIDUM OF THE GOVERNMENT FOR RELATIONS WITH EDITORIAL OFFICES.
