

X/4 CURT -- CEAUSESCU FOR RESPECT OF FREEDOM (RELEADS CN 120 SERIES)

MUNICH, AUGUST 30 (CMD)-- RUMANIAN STATE AND PARTY LEADER NICOLAE CEAUSESCU SAID TODAY, RUMANIA "WANTS TO BE FREE AND THEREFORE RESPECTS FREEDOM OF OTHER PEOPLES."

CEAUESCU SPOKE AT A RALLY IN THE WEST-RUMANIAN TOWN OF CLUJ AND SAID ACCORDING TO RADIO BUCHAREST:

"WE WORKERS OF RUMANIA OFFER A FRIENDLY, COMRADELY HAND TO THE FRATERNAL PEOPLES OF THE SOCIALIST COUNTRIES AND ALSO WANT TO SHAKE A FRIENDLY, COMRADELY HAND IN CONDITIONS OF EQUALITY."

"NOTHING CAN HAMPER THE FRIENDSHIP OF OUR PEOPLES WHO ARE FOLLOWING MARXISM-LENINISM AND CONSTRUCTING THE SAME SOCIALIST AND COMMUNIST SYSTEM. IT SEEMS TO ME I AM HEARING FROM FAR OUR ANCESTORS DECEBAL, TRAJAN, ION DE HUNEDOARA, MIRCEA THE OLD, STEPHAN THE GREAT, MATEI CORVIN, MICHAEL THE BRAVE AND MANY OTHER PEOPLE WHO CONTRIBUTED TO THE RAISING OF OUR NATION, EXHORTING US TO FOLLOW THIS POLICY."

"THEY CALL US TO FIND THE WAYS TO STRENGTHEN AND DEVELOP RELATIONS WITH OUR NEIGHBOUR PEOPLES, BECAUSE SOME OF THEM (OUR ANCESTORS) JOINTLY STRUGGLED AND LED RUMANIANS AND HUNGARIANS IN THE FIGHT AGAINST THE COMMON OPPRESSOR."

THE RADIO FURTHER QUOTED CEAUSESCU AS SAYING THAT ALL THIS HAS BEEN SAID IN ORDER TO SHOW THAT THE RUMANIAN PEOPLE HAS BEHIND IT A GLORIOUS TRADITION.
