X/4 C/S -- FORTY-FIVE KILLED IN SLOVAKIA AND PRAGUE, REPORTS SAY
(RELEADS CN 148)

MUNICH, AUG 30 (CMD)-- THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA BY WARSAW PACT TROOPS HAS CAUSED 45 DEATHS IN SLOVAKIA AND PRAGUE, ACCORDING TO CZECHOSLOVAK RADIOS.

RADIO CENTRAL BOHEMIA REPORTED TONIGHT THAT "ACCORDING TO AN ALL-ROUND REPORT," 25 PEOPLE WERE KILLED IN PRAGUE DURING THE OCCUPATION, WHILE 431 PERSONS IN PRAGUE WERE INJURED OF WHOM 124 ARE STILL HOSPITALIZED.

RADIO FREE DANUBE QUOTED EARLIER TODAY "OFFICIAL REPORTS" AS SAYING THAT 20 PEOPLE WERE KILLED IN SLOVAKIA DURING AND AFTER THE RECENT INVASION BY FOREIGN TROOPS.
