X/4 C/S -- PRAVDA ON C/S DIFFICULTIES AND INSTANCES OF SABOTAGE"

MUNICH, AUG 31 (CMD) - - THE SOVIET COMMUNIST PARTY NEWSPAPER, PRAVDA PUBLISHED TODAY AN ARTICLE SAYING THAT THE PROCESS OF NORMALIZATION IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAD BEGUN, BUT THAT "ONE SHOULD NOT RPT NOT THINK THAT EVERYTHING GOES SMOOTHLY."

THE ARTICLE ALSO SPOKE OF "INSTANCES OF SABOTAGE AT GOVERNMENT INSTITUTIONS AND FACTORIES" AND IN THIS CONNECTION SINGLED OUT THE CASE OF THE RUZYNE AIRPORT OF PRAGUE.

RADIO MOSCOW AND TASS SAID THE ARTICLE WAS WRITTEN BY PRAVDA CORRESPONDENTS B. SDOBOV AND V. ZHURAVSKY, AND BY THE CORRESPONDENT OF THE EKONOMICHESKAYA GAZETA, A. GUDIMOV.

THE ARTICLE, TITLED "DIFFICULTIES AND HOPES," ALLEGED THAT "HOSTILE FORCES HAVE NOT RPT NOT ABANDONED THEIR SINISTER ANTI-NATIONAL DESIGNS. THEIR MALICIOUS VOICES ARE TO BE HEARD TO THIS DAY IN SEMI-LEGAL RADIO BROADCASTS AND NEWSPAPERS AND IN INSCRIPTIONS ON HOUSE WALLS IN VACLAV SQUARE AND OTHER PLACES."

THE ARTICLE SAID THAT ALTHOUGH "COMMON SENSE, THE VOICE OF THE WORKING PEOPLE AND THEIR COMMUNIST PARTY IS COMING THROUGH EVER LOUDER AND FIRMER," ONE "SHOULD NOT RPT NOT THINK THAT EVERYTHING GOES SMOOTHLY."

BOTH TASS AND RADIO MOSCOW MENTIONED PRAVDA'S REFERENCE TO THE SITUATION AT PRAGUE'S RUZYNE AIRPORT.

TASS SAID PRAVDA'S CORRESPONDENT'S "MENTION SPECIFICALLY THE RELUCTANCE OF THE LEADERS OF THE PRAGUE AIRPORT IN RUZYNE TO GET BACK TO NORMAL WORK."
